Removal From ASX List

Dear Shareholders,

The Directors of KneoMedia Limited (**Company** or **KNM**) refer to the ongoing suspension of the Company's shares from trading on the ASX since 7 March 2024, and ASX's policy to remove an entity from the official list if the entity's securities have been suspended from quotation for a continuous period of 2 years (being 7 March 2026, in the case of KNM).

The Company made an application to ASX to extend the delisting deadline, which was ultimately unsuccessful. KNM has been advised by ASX that the Company will be removed from the official list of ASX from Monday 9 March 2026, being the next trading day after the two year anniversary of suspension.

The Company remains a "disclosing entity" for the purposes of the Corporations Act, and will continue to comply with its half and full year financial reporting obligations, and continuous disclosure obligations, by lodging material announcements on its website (<https://www.kneomedia.com>). Shareholders are encouraged to regularly check the Company's website for material updates.

The Directors very much regret these circumstances, however will continue to support the Company as they have in the past and in anticipation of delivering a satisfactory outcome to shareholders.
